Suggestions

The Parish Council is always open to suggestions so if you think of something that will improve or be useful for the village drop us line. Although we cannot promise everything we are happy to consider all new ideas and suggestions. For example more seating on the playing field and down by the river. The river location has been suggested a few times but the problem is vandalism. Reluctantly SKDC agreed to allow us to have a waste bin by the river, it survived awhile until it was thrown in the river!

DOG POO

The issue of dog poo has raised its ugly head again. There are many responsible dog owners in the village but unfortunately there are also some that are not. It is an offence to leave dog poo anywhere in South Kesteven with the one exception, your own garden.

If you are a dog owner, you have a legal duty to clean up every time your dog fouls in a public place. This includes: grass verges, footpaths, roads, public footpaths and bridleways including the Viking Way.

DOG FOULING The Law -

Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005. Authorised officers of the district council are able to issue a Fixed Penalty Notice to anyone found letting a dog under their control to foul in a public place and not clean up after it. It has been reported to the Parish Council that in some cases dog owners either do not pick the poo up or they leave it lying around in bags. Both scenarios are offensive and against the law. On occasion these bags have been left on consecrated ground this is not acceptable. Please retain your bags until you get home or find a public waste bin.

Dog faeces are not a pleasant sight, they smell disgusting, are easy to tread in particularly for small children as one small child found out last week. Having had a new pair of shoes ruined by an inconsiderate dog owner.



The Parish Council does not want to take on extreme measures such as CCTV but it will have to if some residents continue to act irresponsibly and do not pick up after their dogs. So please be a responsible dog owner and clear up after your dog, thank you!
