#### **Report Dog fouling to SKDC**

The Parish Council would like to thank all residents who pick up after their dogs and either bin it or take it home with them.

For those that do not, South Kesteven District Council (SKDC) has authorised officers who are able to issue a Fixed Penalty Notice of £75 to anyone found letting a dog under their control foul in a public place and not clean up after it. This includes all grass verges, public footpaths, pavements, roads, farmers' fields and anywhere other than your own garden.

If you see a dog owner not picking up after their dog please report the dog owner to SKDC. They will use the information you provide to help target their work to tackle and prevent dog fouling problems.

The Parish Council has another dog waste bin to install and please remember the bin is emptied by a member of the Parish Council because SKDC will not empty them for us! So please bag it and bin it and if a bin is full please take your package home with you. Think of the volunteer who has to pick up your dog's waste left in little bags under the bin or left lying around the village. Leaving bags around the village will not help in our quest to do better in the Best Kept Village Competition this year.
