Please look out for a questionnaire coming your way soon to check that the Neighbourhood Plan Working Group have got the policies for the plan in line with village thinking.


Planning

Wind Turbine Top Farm, The Top Farm Turbine appeal, we are still waiting for news.

Wind Farm Reference S15/0862 Location Thackson Well Farm, Sewstern Lane, Long Bennington, Newark, Lincolnshire, NG23 5EX. The proposal is for the erection of six wind turbines. If you would like to comment write to Planning Department SKDC St Peters Hill Grantham by the 5th June.

The proposal is for six wind turbines with a height to blade tip of up to 110m and a total generating capacity of up to 18MW. The planning application is for the erection, operation and subsequent decommissioning of the wind turbines and associated infrastructure. The proposed location is

approximately 2km to the northwest of Allington, and 2km southwest of Foston if you would like to comment click on link - http://www.southkesteven.gov.uk/index.aspx ?articleid=2230&ApplicationNumber=S15/08 62 and click on "Comment on this application" responses to be in by 5th June.

Big Community 'Switch' collective energy scheme

Together they will find you a good deal and an easy way to switch energy suppliers.

How does the scheme work?

1. Sign up for free to express your interest.

- 2. You can sign up any time up to and including 18 May 2015.
- 3. Energy suppliers are then invited to take part in the auction to bid against each other to offer the best deal. This takes place on 19 May 2015.
- 4. The winning supplier will be the one making the lowest offer. You will receive an email from 29 May 2015 with an offer, based on the usage information you have submitted. You are under no obligation unless you decide to switch.
- 5. If you decide to accept the offer you need to let SKDC know before 30 June 2015.

If you're not able to register online, you can register offline at your local council or by calling 0800 048 8439 FREE until 5pm on Monday May 18. - Anyone can register, whether you rent your home or own it. Do hurry as this offer ends on the 18th May.
