# **First Aid Training**

On Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> September the Parish Council organised another First Aid Training Course, provided by Newark Community First Aid. Key skills were taught including how to manage a casualty, control severe bleeding and how to use a defibrillator. The session was very useful and the Parish Council will organise another one if there is a request for more.



The defibrillator is a device that gives a high energy electric shock to the heart through the chest wall to someone who is in cardiac arrest. The Parish Council's defibrillator is located on Main Street in the old BT telephone box.

**VERY IMPORTANT** If the occasion arises when you need to use a defibrillator.

## This is what you will need to do -

Telephone the Emergency Services and ask for an Ambulance and for the code for the defibrillator box on Main Street. Foston.

The Ambulance Service gives you the key code for the defibrillator box and will stay on the telephone line with you until help arrives.

Once you have the code then send somebody to get the defibrillator for you while you continue Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). The defibrillators are designed to help people with minimal training **use** them safely in emergency situations. They have numerous built-in safeguards and are designed to deliver a shock only if the Automated External Defibrillator (AED) detects one or more shocks are necessary.

There has been a sharp increase in reports about fake TV Licensing emails claiming to offer refunds. The emails state that the refund cannot be processed due to "invalid account details". The links provided in the emails lead to phishing websites designed to steal personal and financial details.

Always question any unsolicited requests for your personal or financial information in case it's a scam. Never automatically click on a link in an unexpected email or text.

Lincolnshire Police have been notified of a fraud whereby victims receive an email claiming that they are due a tax refund. Please be aware, HMRC will never contact you by email, text message or telephone call regarding a tax refund or penalty. You can report something suspicious to HMRC's phishing team by forwarding texts to 60599 (you'll be charged the network rate) or via email to phishing@hmrc.gsi.gov.uk
