**Minutes of the Extraordinary Meeting of George Nympton & Queen's Nympton Parish Council**

**14<sup>th</sup> September 2017**

**2017/058-Apologies/Attendance Register**- Apologies received from Richard Toller who was on holiday and from Mark Dean & Andy Warren who had work commitments.

**2017/059-Disclosable Pecuniary Interests**- There were none.

**2017/060-Announcements from The Chair**-There were none.

**2017/061-Democratic 15 minutes/Public Question Time**-There were no members of the public present.

**2017/062-Dispensation Requests**- There were none.

**2017/063-Minutes of previous meeting**-It was noted that item 2017/051 had an incomplete sentence. To be amended and presented for approval at next week's meeting.

**2017/064-Planning Matters**-Planning application no.63715. Construction of new access road at Hele Farm, Old Alswear Road. The council voted unanimously to recommend approval.
