Application 60842: Relocation of approved infrastructure & construction of additional structures at the anaerobic digestion plant at Great Hele Farm, Great Hele Lane, South Molton.

The increased output from the plant and lack of clarity re storage were discussed.

Five councillors voted unanimously against the applications. Richard Toller & roger Gay did not vote.

Councillors voted unanimously in favour of the application
