

Boroughbridge Community Library (Working in conjunction with NYCC)

You may be wondering who or what "BACLA" is......



"BACLA" is an acronym for BOROUGHBRIDGE AREA COMMUNITY LIBRARY ASSOCIATION which came into existence in mid-2011when NYCC was debating whether to close our local library altogether or reduce the number of hours during which it is open. In the event, the County

Council decided that it didn't need to save *quite* as much money as was at first thought to be necessary and the result (for the time being at least) was a reduction in hours of opening.

While County were deliberating, the community asked a small group of people (mainly members of local councils) to get together as a kind of "action group" to see what could be done to maintain a full range of library services in the town, for the benefit of both Boroughbridge and the Lower Ure Valley

In June, 2012, BACLA volunteers began to work in the library, following a period of induction and training

At the present time (June, 2016), the following local people make up the BACLA committee:

"What does BACLA actually do?" you may ask. Well, we operate under two broad headings:

- 1. On Wednesday mornings (9 am to I pm) we run the library on the basis of a highly trained group of 12 volunteers, on a rota basis
- 2. We also manage the <u>upstairs</u> of the library which is now referred to as the Jubilee Room, for fairly obvious reasons. In fact we have taken over the marketing and management of the Jubilee Room, seven days a week, from NYCC. Booking costs have been significantly reduced because



we do our own cleaning and there is no longer a fee for "caretaking" (opening and closing the library in the evenings)

The expectation is that BACLA will in due course (not later than April 1, 2017) take over the running of the library from NYCC and negotiations are currently taking place between BACLA and NYCC with that end in view
