INTRODUCTION

Welcome to Helston Town Council's Annual report for the Civic Year 2011/2012.

This year has been a very busy one for the Town Council, and I would like to thank the Town Clerk and his thoroughly professional and intrepid team of staff in the office, who have once again provided essential back room support for the Council. I would also like to thank our Community Network Manager, Mrs Charlotte Chadwick, and our Divisional Members on Cornwall Council, Councillors Mrs Judith Haycock, Alec Robertson and Andrew Wallis, for all their help and support during the year.

Last year, the Council said farewell to two Members, Councillors Mrs Vicki Matthew and Mrs Wendy Radford-Gaby, whom we thanked for their service and wished well for the future. Elected to serve in their places were Councillors Miss Justine Hornsby and John Martin, whom we welcomed in January.

It was a great pleasure to be present at the opening ceremony of the Furry Youth Café, and to see firsthand how the Peoples' Millions funds had been spent in creating a superb new facility for the young people of the town.

At the end of 2011, we said farewell and thank you to Mr Richard Dennery, Town Centre Manager, who left us for pastures new, and we welcomed in his place Mr Jonathan Birkett in February, and Mrs Tanya Allen, his assistant, in May.



For me, it was an enormous honour and great pleasure in May to be elected Mayor of the wonderful and ancient town of Helston and, as I said in my acceptance speech, I intend to use my time in office to particularly celebrate the people of the town, without whose hard work in all sorts of voluntary capacities, our town would be greatly the poorer. I pledged myself to the service of the town and its people when I took office in May, and I take this opportunity to renew that pledge now.

The town had a wonderful boost earlier this year with the opening of the Old Cattle Market facility at the bottom of town. I would like to formally congratulate the Directors and staff of the South Kerrier Alliance for the successful delivery of such an amazing project. The visionary leadership of the Directors has had fantastic results and leaves a legacy for the town that will endure many years into the future. The offices are, as I write, fully let and the bookings for the halls on the ground floor are almost at capacity – not forgetting, of course, the Old Cattle Market houses the biggest and best monthly Farmers' Market Cornwall has ever seen! Shortly after I took office, it was a great honour for the Mayoress and I to meet HRH The Princess Royal, the Mayor of London, the Deputy Prime Minister and various other dignitaries and celebrities, during the arrival of the Olympic Torch into RNAS Culdrose, and then to witness it passing through our town on the following morning. We are very much looking forward to the start of the Olympic Games themselves in late July.

One of our most notable landmarks, the Coronation Boating Lake, turns 100 years old next month, and I am looking forward also to the celebrations which are being planned to mark this momentous event. There will be posters around the town to advertise the events – keep an eye out for them and keep fingers crossed for good weather for the day! We are looking forward also to the summer evening markets, which are being planned by our Town Centre Manager for Meneage Street on Wednesday afternoons and evenings throughout August – watch this space!

Speaking of markets and matters commercial, it was an honour to be asked to be a Director of the Helston Business Improvement Partnership, a company (not for profit) set up by businesses of the Town to improve commercial viability and maximise the capacity of the town centre. I am certain the Helston Business Improvement Partnership and Helston Town Council will forge a strong working relationship. As I write, the first joint venture, the hanging baskets, are about to be erected, and I hope very much that the town will be a blaze of colour during the forthcoming holiday season.

I know that there is another very busy civic year ahead, and I would like to take this opportunity to thank my Deputy Mayor, Councillor Mike Thomas, the Chairmen of the various committees, and all my colleagues on the Town Council, for their continuing kind support. I look forward to working with them for the forthcoming civic year.

THE COUNCIL

Meetings of the Full Council are held on the third Thursday of every month and are open to the public. Time is set aside at these meetings for the public to ask questions or to make their personal views known. A representative of the Devon and Cornwall Constabulary is usually present to report on crime statistics and to discuss issues as they arise. There is also an agenda item for the Cornwall Council Local Members and the Community Network Manager to give reports and they attend when possible.

AMENITIES COMMITTEE

This Committee has responsibility for civic amenities, such as public seats and bus shelters, along with the Council's land and buildings to name a few. The Committee has also been responsible for organising the Saturday Street Markets in Coinagehall Street to increase footfall within the town. The Committee is Chaired by Cllr Mrs Susan Swift and met on eight occasions during the 2011/12 civic year.

HARVEST FAIR COMMITTEE

The Town Council assumed responsibility for the organisation of the Annual Harvest Fair in 2007 and formed the Harvest Fair Committee which consisted of six Town Councillors and six members of the community. The Committee then created a number of Working Parties to organise the individual events. The main Committee, Chaired by Cllr Mrs Boase, met on four occasions during the civic year with the final meeting being held after the Harvest Fair in October 2011. The event has now been returned to the community following the formation of an independent committee which is currently busy organising Harvest Fair 2012 to take place during the weekend of 8th and 9th September.

PLANNING COMMITTEE

The Planning Committee, consisting of six Members was Chaired by Cllr Jonathan Radford-Gaby during 2011/12. The Committee meets on the first and third Thursday of every month and has delegated authority to consider all planning applications and to make recommendations to Cornwall Council - the Planning Authority. All Applications are categorised into those that are non-contentious (Category I) and those that require more in-depth consideration (Category II). Each Category II application is allocated to a Committee member who visits the site and contacts neighbours to establish a balanced view and to make a presentation and recommendation at the Planning Committee meeting. If a near neighbour of the application site cannot be contacted a letter is left giving the application details and how to contact the Committee member. The public are welcome to attend the meeting and again have the opportunity to express their opinions to the Members.

From June 2011 to May 2012, 29 Category I planning applications were considered and 80 Category II.

PLAY COMMITTEE AND PLAY & YOUNG PEOPLE COMMITTEE

The Play Committee which consisted of six Town Councillors and a maximum of six members of the public was Chaired by Cllr Mike Thomas and met on one occasion at the beginning of the Civic Year. The Play Committee's remit included the maintenance of the Town Council-owned play area in addition to the provision of new play equipment. It was agreed by the Full Council to expand the remit of the Committee which led to the dissolution of the Play Committee and the formation of the Play & Young People Committee in June 2011. The composition of Play & Young People Committee continued to be six Councillors and a maximum of six members of the public and Cllr Mike Thomas was elected Chair. The Committee's responsibilities include the investigation and promotion of youth engagement in addition to seeking the provision of new play equipment and the Committee met four times during the Civic Year.

POLICY, FINANCE & RESOURCES COMMITTEE

The Policy, Finance and Resources Committee, consisting of six Members, Chaired by Councillor Keith Reynolds, met on fourteen occasions during the year. The Committee meetings are held on the second Tuesday of every month and its functions include the consideration of new policies, monitoring the budget and audit of the Council's accounts and internal controls.
