(a) On "Stand To" all the Police Strength including the Special Constabulary are mobilised and essential plans of policy are overhauled in preparation of "Action Station". The Chairman of the Invasion Committee, the A.R.P. and F.E.O. are notified, (should they fail to have the information from any other source). One member posted with the Invasion Committee.

Non-essential traffic will be advised to return home and immobilise.

At "Action Stations" personnel are allocated to various posts in accordance with prevailing conditions, i.e. A.R.P. and Control Points.

Personnel will be posted at outlets to populous areas and public advised in accordance with the "Stand Firm" policy also do all in their power to sustain the public morale.

Non-essential pigeons will be destroyed and the immobilisation of petrol and vehicles will be governed by the military situation.

(b) The Police will control the roads so that the Service and essential traffic is not obstructed in their respective actions and duties, the closing of roads being governed by the situation.

Road Blocks will probably be resorted to and controlled in conjunction with the Military (if available) at Monument Road, Clodgy Lane, Hospital (junction with Helston - Lizard and Clodgy Lane) and Sithney School.

(c) Everything possible will be done to get refugees off the roads by directing them to woods, cover and Rest Centres.

C. Equipment.

1. Ambulances. Three and one trailer.
2. Stretchers. Six at Ambulance Station, Wendron Street, Helston. Four in each ambulance and two in the trailer ambulance, making 20 in all.
3. Beds, Blankets etc. (see 6 (b) above).
4. Chemists stocks (including invalid foods).

D. System for the collection and disposal of casualties.

1. Military ~~for the collection~~ - a casualties are collected by their own personnel and the arrangements vary according to the circumstances.
2. Home Guard has casualty collecting posts near all defence posts.
3. Civilian & Enemy. The Civil Defence Organization is responsible for the collection of all casualties.

Dispersal of casualties from the hospitals is under the direction of the County M.O. who will direct to which of the Casualty Receiving Hospitals, casualties are to be sent and in that event transport will be sent to fetch the casualties. Subject to this, dispersal must depend upon the circumstances from time to time.
