Upon an invasion becoming imminent, the Ministry of War Transport will give all possible help in finding transport for urgent emergency services upon messages being sent to the office at Truro, through the Invasion Committee.

In the event of serious air raids, the Ministry will assist in finding transport for all essential services.

The powers of the Minister of War Transport under the Defence Regulations have been delegated to the District Transport Officer and any question arising must be referred to that officer or to Mr. W.M. Upex, his deputy.

When military operations are in progress in this area, most mechanically propelled vehicles will have been immobilised in order to deny their use to the enemy and such transport should not be applied for in an invaded area.
